Behind the scenes staff spotlight: Kevin Yau (tafLabs)

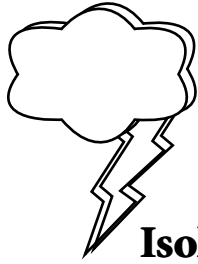
Name/Age/Hometown: Kevin Yau, 27, Alhambra, CA
